

### **DVD REAR SEAT VIDEO SYSTEM**




#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Vehicles equipped with REC Navigation Radio will require an upgrade so that the vehicle speakers will function when a DVD is playing.

### **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- Scissors
  Sharp utility knife
  New roll of masking tape
  Non-metal trim stick
  Hooked Pick Tool
- 10mm Socket
  Socket wrench
  T15, T20, T25 Torx driver
  Magnetized T15 torx driver
- T50 Torx bit Tape Measure Torque wrench Metal wire routing tool Strong adhesive tape
- · Diagnostic STAR SCAN tool






### A - Trim Out the Headliner:

- Trim out supplied template (Item 1) along the doted lines as indicated for vehicles with or without sunroof.
- **2)** Position and tape template to the headliner where indicated.
- **3)** Measure 20" (508mm) from the rear of overhead console to the front of template.


### NOTE: Make sure the sunshade (if equipped) is closed.

4) Trim out the headliner using a sharp utility knife.




### **B** – Interior Trim Panel and Component Removal:


- 1) Disconnect and isolate negative battery cable.
- **2)** Remove left sun visor (two T25 screws). Disengage left sun visor retaining clip.
- 3) Disconnect and remove the overhead console.
- **4)** Open the cap plugs in the left A-pillar trim panel and remove the panel (two screws/10mm wrench).




- 5) Remove cap plugs from left and right B-pillar trim panels. Remove one screw each side using a magnetized T15 driver.
- **6)** Remove T15 shoulder belt turning loop bolts, then remove the trim panels.




- Disconnect and remove left and right headliner grab handles (two T20 screws).
- 8) Remote left and right C-pillar trim panels



- 9) Remove center console radio bezel.
- **10)** Remove the radio (four phillips screws).



- **11)** Remove and discard back cover from the rear of floor console.
- **12)** Remove one T15 screw from the right side of floor console.




NOTE: The following Steps 15-17 apply only to vehicles without sunroof.


- **13)** Remove upper liftgate trim panel.
- 14) Remove left and right D-pillar trim panels.
- 15) Remove two retainers from rear edge of headliner.

### C1 - Install Screen Console Mounting Bracket on Vehicles with Sunroof:

### NOTE: See next page for install on vehicles without sunroof.

1) Install two u-nuts (Item 2A) on each side of the left and right sunroof inner frame.







2) Carefully slide the screen console mounting bracket (Item 3A) between headliner and sunroof middle beam.

## CAUTION! Stay clear of the side curtain airbags, if equipped.

- **3)** Align three holes in the center of mounting bracket with those in the middle beam.
- 4) Install three M5 screws (Item 4A).




- 5) Install two M6 hex flange screws (Items 5A) to each end of mounting bracket and into the u-nuts. Tighten to 80 in.-lbs. (9 N·m).
- **6)** Tighten the three M5 bolts to 85 in.-lbs. (9.6 N·m).




# C2 – <u>Install Screen Console Mounting Bracket on Vehicles</u> without Sunroof:


- 1) Install four u-nuts (Item 2B) to slots in the front and rear roof crossbow as shown.
- 2) Carefully slide the screen console mounting bracket (Item 3B) forward from rear opening of headliner.
- **3)** Lock the mounting bracket's rear tab to slot in the rear roof crossbow.
- **4)** Slide the mounting bracket's front tab to slot in the front roof crossbow.



- **5)** Align two holes in the front of mounting bracket to those in the front roof crossbow and the previously installed u-nuts.
- **6)** Install two M6 bolts (Item 4B) using a 10mm socket.




- 7) Install two M6 bolts through holes in the rear of mounting bracket, rear roof crossbow and into the u-nuts.
- 8) Tighten the four bolts to 105 in.-lbs. (11.8  $N \cdot m$ ).



#### D – Install Overhead Harness and Power Harness:


- 1) Carefully lower the headliner and let it rest on the front and rear seat headrests.
- 2) Starting at the left (driver's side) rear door, route black connector on overhead harness (Item 6) under headliner and out of trimmed opening. Leave approximately 4" (101mm) of harness exposed.
- **3)** Route harness forward along trough in headliner foam block as shown.
- **4)** Using a a strong adhesive tape, secure harness to the inside of headliner



5) At this time the headliner must be positioned back in place. Re-install all the pillar trim panels, sun visor/retaining clip, and overhead console.


### NOTE: Tighten left and right shoulder belt turning loop T50 bolts to 29 ft.-lbs. (39 N·m).

- **6)** Detach left front door weatherstrip from the top of I/P to the top of door sill.
- 7) Remove lower I/P closeout panel (two phillips screws) and drop down the knee blocker.




- 8) Continue to route overhead harness down the left A-pillar and secure it to the rear window washer feed hose using three tie straps (Item 7).
- **9)** Route harness across the inside of knee blocker opening and through to the lower right center console trim panel.

NOTE: Secure harness away from any heat sources, sharp edges, or moving parts.




- **10)** Hand feed 12-way connector on power harness (Item 8) into radio opening and down the right side of center console.
- **11)** Plug 22-way connectors in-between the radio and radio harness connector.
- 12) Plug 10-way connector into the radio.

NOTE: If there is a 10-way connector already present in the radio, it means that the vehicle is equipped with Satellite Radio. Refer to the following procedure (A-F) and graphic:




- a) Unplug 10-way connector from the radio.
- **b)** Using a hooked pick tool lift up the connector locking wedge slightly (do not remove it entirely).
- **c)** Remove the three wires from connector and discard it.

- **d)** Lift up the 10-way power harness connector locking wedge slightly.
- **e)** Insert the three wires into 10-way power harness connector as shown at left.
- **f)** Engage locking wedge and plug connector into the radio.




- **13)** Route power harness and overhead harness rearward behind right side of floor console and under the carpet liner.
- **14)** Position the harness connectors approximately 6" (152mm) out of the rear console's end cap mounting tabs.
- **15)** Bundle up any slack in the harness, tape, and tuck neatly inside of center console.

NOTE: Make sure the power harness and overhead harness remain under the carpet liner to prevent rattles.




### E - Install DVD Player and Screen Console:


1) Install bracket (Item 9) to DVD player (Item 10) with four T25 screws (Item 11).




2) Install bracket/DVD player to the appropriately colored end cap/lid assembly (Item 12) with four T15 screws (Item 13).



- Plug 12-way power harness connector and 16-way overhead harness connector into the back of DVD player.
- **4)** Fully engage the DVD bracket's two hook tabs to the floor console bottom mounting slots.
- 5) Snap four retaining clips on the DVD bracket into the floor console mounting slots. Make sure the harnesses are not pinched or crimped.



- **6)** Plug and lock overhead harness connector into the screen console (Item 14).
- 7) Snap four retaining clips on the top of screen console into the mounting bracket slots.
- 8) Open the screen and carefully remove the attached DVD remote (Item 15).
- Peel and stick mercury warning label (Item 16) to lower portion of forward facing surface of the left (driver's side) B-pillar.



#### F - Finalize Installation and Perform Operation Test:

- **1)** Re-install all previously removed components, panels, and fasteners.
- 2) Re-connect the vehicle's battery.
- Place supplied batteries (Item 17) into both headphones (Item 18) as shown.
- 4) Place batteries into DVD remote.

- **5)** Turn on ignition and the unit will power up.
- **6)** Use a diagnostic STARSCAN tool so that the Front Control Module (FCM) is reconfigured and recognizes the Video Entertainment System (VES). Follow the procedure shown below.

### IN THE INITIAL START UP SCREEN

- PRESS ----- VEHICLE PREPARATION
- TOGGLE DOWN AND HIGHLIGHT -----

PROGRAM NETWORK CONFIGURATION FCM (CGW)

- PRESS ----- START
- PRESS ----- NEXT>
- TOGGLE DOWN AND HIGHLIGHT ----- VES
- PRESS ----- ADD

FOLLOW ON SCREEN PROMPTS (I.E. CYCLE IGNITION KEY)

- PRESS ----- NEXT>
- PRESS ----- FINISH
- 7) Insert a known good DVD into the player.
- 8) Verify function of headphones and DVD remote using supplied Operating Instructions (Item 19).
- 9) Place Operating Instructions in the vehicle's glove box.
