#### SUBJECT:

Hard Start/No Start Due to Weak Battery

## **OVERVIEW:**

This bulletin involves checking for ignition off power draw caused by the radio and if necessary replace the radio.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to the above listed vehicles equipped with a MYGIG radio (sales code REN, REP, RER, REW or REZ) built before February 8, 2008 (MDH 0208XX).

## SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

Vehicle operator may experience weak or dead battery condition. This may be caused by the radio not powering down properly and keeping the communication buss awake causing a parasitic battery draw.



## **DIAGNOSIS:**

- Sit in vehicle with windows and doors closed.
- 2. Turn off and remove key from ignition.
- 3. Wait 30 to 40 seconds.
- 4. Inspect radio backlight for flickering approximately every 20 seconds. Does backlight flicker and repeat about every 20 seconds?
  - Yes >>> Perform the Repair Procedure.
  - No >>> Further diagnosis is required, this bulletin does not apply. Perform the
    existing diagnostic procedure available in DealerCONNECT > TechCONNECT
    under: Service Info > DIAGNOSIS AND TESTING > ELECTRICAL > BATTERY
    SYSTEM > DIAGNOSIS AND TESTING.

- 4. Program customers station presets recorded in Step #1
- 5. Reset clock to correct time if applicable.
