SUBJECT:

Cleaning Protective Plastic Film Residue From Interior Trim

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves the removal of plastic protective film adhesive residue from the interior trim.

MODELS:

2005 (WK/WH) Grand Cherokee

DISCUSSION:

For quality purposes a thin plastic film is used to protect various interior trim surfaces. To maximize the protection offered by the plastic film it is recommended that the film not be removed until the vehicle is to be delivered to the new vehicle owner. This means that the plastic film should remain attached to the various interior trim components while the vehicle is in dealer inventory awaiting purchase.

When the protective plastic film is removed a residue may remain on an interior trim component surface. The residue may be removed using **Mopar Total Clean cleaner**. Testing has shown that Total Clean is effective at removing the film residue without damage to the interior trim components. This may not be true of other aftermarket cleaners. The part numbers for Total Clean are: 04897840AA (16 oz. spray bottle) and 04318020AB (1 gallon bottle).

The protective plastic film is applied to the following interior trim components:

- Center console lid / arm rest
- Lower cowl / kick panel both front sides
- Sill / scuff plate both front door openings
- Door arm rest all four doors
- Map pocket both front doors
